Overnight Parking Information

(updated May / 2021)

You must register and pay to have your vehicle parked within any Minnesota state park if your vehicle will be within the park after 10:00 p.m.

There are two types of Minnesota State Park parking permits:

- A **current yearly** Minnesota State Park permit (affixed to the lower passenger side of the front window). The cost is \$35.00 for a full year from the month of purchase.
- A **daily parking pass** for each night your vehicle will be in the park past 10:00 p.m. The daily cost is \$7.00.

The easiest way to pay is <u>online</u>, or to arrive during the day while the park staff is available. If you arrive after hours, or find that there are no state park staff available to assist you, please follow these instructions.

<u>Self-Service Instructions for Parking at Tettegouche State Park</u>

1. Find the self-service kiosk building where campers register:

At Hwy. 61 (mile post 58.5) turn right. Tettegouche S.P. has both a big main Visitor Center building and a small kiosk to the right of the Visitor Center. If the Visitor Center is open, go there to register. If the Visitor Center is closed, use the kiosk, which is actually a small part of a building where firewood is sold. By the way you can also get what you need for Crosby-Manitou SP here as well.

2. Fill out the Minnesota State Parks payment envelope:

Envelopes are available at the registration building. If you purchase a year-round permit, they will mail it to you. You can pay by cash, check, or credit card (fill out the credit card information on the envelope).

Fill out your mailing address in the space provided. Write your vehicle license plate number on both the envelope and the rip-off tab. Put the rip-off tab (proof of purchase) on the dashboard of your vehicle. Put your payment in the envelope and place it in the night deposit box at the self-service kiosk building.

3. What to do if you already have a yearly state park permit:

You **must still** fill out your vehicle information on the envelope. Put the rip-off tab receipt on the dashboard of your vehicle and put the envelope in the night deposit box at the registration building. No additional payment is due.

4. Where to park and wait for us to pick you up:

As you leave the parking lot in in front of the Visitor Center, turn left (toward the river). You will go down a hill, cross over the Baptism River (on a very narrow bridge) and then actually drive under Hwy. 61.

The "Trail Center" lot is about one mile up the hill after going under the highway. Look for a sign that says "Trail Center" and the lot is about 40 yards further inland. A 250 yard spur trail goes from this lot up to the SHT.
